

## PRINT RESOURCES

- ❖ **Textbooks:** The library has a substantial collection of textbooks, with **7791 items**. Textbooks are essential for formal education, providing comprehensive coverage of subjects for students.
- ❖ **Book Bank:** There are **541 books** available through the book bank. This is likely a scheme where students can borrow books for an extended period, possibly for a semester or academic year, easing the financial burden of purchasing textbooks.
- ❖ **Reference books:** The library holds **180 reference books**, which are consulted for specific facts or information and are typically not for loan.
- ❖ **Journals:** There is one journal in the collection. Libraries commonly offer both print and digital journals.
- ❖ **Practical Manuals:** There are **123 practical manuals**, suggesting the library caters to practical or vocational learning needs.
- ❖ **M-Tech Thesis:** The library has **10 M-tech thesis**. These are important for research and scholarship, often documenting original research by graduate students.
- ❖ **Newspapers:** **Seven newspapers** are available, providing a source of current events and information.
- ❖ **Bound Volumes:** There are **136 bound volumes** in the collection. These may include bound sets of journals, newspapers, or other materials, providing a more permanent and organized form of older materials.
- ❖ **In-Plant Training Reports:** The library has **576 in-plant training reports**. These documents provide valuable information on practical experience gained during internships or industrial training.
